Papers must be submitted in English. Papers should **not exceed 15 pages** including title, authors and their affiliations, abstract, sections headings (such as introduction, experimental, results, discussion, conclusions, etc.), text, tables, figures and references.

Papers will be reviewed by members of the Editorial Committee for technical merit, scientific content, and relevance to the theme of the IBAAS 2013 Symposium.

2. Format

The current document is formatted as per the for IBAAS 2013 print requirements. Please strictly comply with the formatting requirements and use this document as a template for your Paper/Abstract.

Abstract and Keywords 3.2

The word Abstract should be in Bold, Constantia 11 pt font, Left justified with 1 blank line above and below, separating it from the abstract text of **500** words maximum.

All **keywords** can be marked in 'Bold lettering'. A maximum of 6 key words per abstract is recommended.

Sections 3.3

Titles of sections and subsections (introduction, experimental, results, discussion, conclusions, etc.) should all be in **bold** and aligned to the left margin with one blank line above, separating the title of each section from the preceding text and one blank line below separating it from the following text.

Numbering of titles of sections and subsections (if any) should be according to the number format used in the current document (1.1, 1.2, 1.3 etc.)

Equations 3.4

All equations will be centered (using a center tab position) and a sequential number in parenthesis will be at the right hand side of each equation (using a right tab at position 14 cm). A preceding and succeeding blank line should separate them from the text. For example:

$$F = m \cdot a \tag{1}$$

- F Force (N)
- mass (kg) m
- acceleration (m/s²)

Tables, figures and illustrations 3.5

Tables, figures and illustrations should normally be inserted at the appropriate position in the paper. Arabic numerals are to be used for numbering tables.

Table headings shall be bold and centered and placed on top of the related tables.

Figure captions shall be bold and centered and placed below the related figures.

All figures (photographs, drawings, diagrams) should be numbered with consecutive Arabic numerals in the same order as they are referred to in the text. (Fig 1:, Table 3: etc)

Photographs shall normally be printed in black and white and, where relevant; a scale marker is added to show magnification.

The maximum size of illustrations is 5.5 x 8 inches.
