SECURING OUR FUTURE-St. Joseph Capital Campaign As of 12/31/2015 we have received 123 pledges for a total pledge amount of \$227,200.48. Of that amount pledged we have received \$120,139.48 in cash.

Reflections on the readingsToday we hear Saint Paul proclaim that he exercises stewardship of "God's grace" for the benefit of the Christian community. Earlier in this letter to the Ephesians, he prayed they would come to realize the actual value of

"these riches" of God's grace they inherited. JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY For this Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy, Bishop Gaydos has designated five church as pilgrimage sites at which there will be a Holy Door of Mercy and the opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence for the Jubilee. Those churches are 1. The Cathedral of St. Joseph; 2. The Church of St. Peter in Brush Creek (where Fr. Augustine Tolton was baptized, whose cause for canonization is in process); 3. St. Joseph in Edina; 4. The church of St. Patrick in Laurie in honor of the Shrine of Mary, Mother of the Church (at the lake of the Ozarks) 5. The shrine of Our Lady of Sorrows in Starkendburg. You are all encouraged to make a pilgrimage to receive the Lord's mercy and to share that mercy with others.

<u>CHURCH PAINTING</u> Starting January 11, we will begin the painting works in the church and hope to get it over by Palm Sunday. Hence, with due permission from Bishop Gaydos, all the Masses will be said in the Farischon Hall. During this period one will be able to visit the Blessed Sacrament only during office hours. Other times one will have to be satisfied with only the spiritual visit to the Blessed Sacrament, until we resume our Masses in the Church.

Again for security reasons sometime within the next two weeks we are changing the lock of the Farischon Hall. At present there are some keys which were issued to some people and never returned. If those keys fall into wrong hands then we will be in trouble. Anyone who really needs a key should return the old key and get the new key. This will help us update our record of who has got the key.

<u>CHRISTMAS SEMINARY COLLECTION</u> Remember that the parish has an assessment from the diocese each year. This year it is in the amount of \$3,089.00. The Christmas collection goes to pay for the assessment which is for the Seminary and Priestly Retirement Fund.

<u>CATHOLIC STEWARDSHIP APPEAL</u> We thank all parishioners who have given generously to the annual Catholic Stewardship Appeal. We ask those of you who have not sent in your pledge to please consider a gift to finance the services and support provided by diocesan staff to parishes and beyond. So far, St. Joseph Parish, Palmyra has raised \$10,924 of their CSA goal of \$15,190, with a total of 54 parishioners participating.


