REFLECTIONS ON THE READINGS: In today's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." At the end of the reading Jesus suggests there is great hope in the cross. Today's followers of Christ recognize they are stewards of his entire legacy, including his cross and that

through their mutual sacrifices God's glory is revealed. They don't live their lives in Christ only when it is convenient for them. They make a decision to take up their cross and carry it, no matter what the cost is to themselves. Reflect this week on the cross you bear in order to reveal God's glory. How do you embrace that cross? How, at times, do you shirk that cross when it is not convenient?

QUESTIONS OF THE WEEK Jesus bids me "deny myself" before "taking up the cross" and "following." What radical shift of values, reordering of priorities, refocusing of vision must take place in my heart as discipleship's non-negotiable Step Number 1?

Bishop John R. Gaydos has directed parishes throughout these 38 counties to take up a special collection for hurricane relief during the weekend of Sept. 9-10

"The devastation is horrific, and the needs are tremendous," Bishop Gaydos noted. "We must step up and be a sacrificial answer to prayers, while continuing our own fervent intercession for all the people affected by this historic weather, its aftermath and the long recovery that will follow."

Funds given to the collection will support the humanitarian and recovery efforts of Catholic Charities USA and will provide pastoral and rebuilding support to impacted dioceses through the USCCB.
