

CAS Dress Code

K3 — 12th Boys

Shirts: solid or neatly patterned collared shirt No Flannel Shirts

No large logos or writing Short or long sleeve

Must be tucked in at all times

Jackets and sweaters, may be worn over school uniform. No large logos or writing.

Pants: tan, black, brown, gray, or navy dress pants (No cargo pants or jeans)

Shorts (K4—6th only): tan, black, or navy uniform shorts no shorter than the top of the knee.

A belt must be worn at all times.

K3 — 6th Grade Girls

Tops: solid or neatly patterned collared shirt No Flannel Shirts
No large logos or writing
Short or long sleeve

Jackets and sweaters may be worn over school uniform. No large logos or writing

Bottoms: tan, black, brown, gray, or navy dress slacks, dress capris, skorts, skirts, or jumpers with a collard shirt

- Length of skirt no shorter than the top of the kneecap
- Slits no higher than the bend in the back of the knee
- Undergarments or undergarment lines not visible
- Shorts or leggings worn under the knee length skirt are acceptable
- No jeggings

Shorts: tan, black, or navy uniform shorts no shorter than the top of the knee.































7th - 12th Grade Girls

















Solid or neatly patterned collared shirt No flannel shirts No large logos or writing Short or long sleeve

Jackets and sweaters may be worn over school uniforms. No large logos or writing.

Skirts: tan, black, brown, gray, or navy

- Length of skirt must be to the knee while standing or walking
- Slits no higher than the bend in the back of the knee
- Leggings worn under knee length skirt are acceptable

Pants: Loose-fitting "**uniform**" pants (tan, black, brown, gray, or navy) Acceptable cuts: Bootcut, Pixie Cut, Harper Full Length pant (at Old Navy)

- May not have "patch pockets" on either the legs or the seat (slit pockets only)
- No "skinny" cut or jeggings

Jeans are not permitted at any school function including field trips and ballgames.









General Guidelines for All

Footwear:

Girls: No beach flip flops or excessively high heels

Boys: No flip flops or sandals

Appearance of clothing:

- Clothing should not be too tight...
- Clothing should not be faded or torn.
- Only the top button of shirts may be unbuttoned
- Undergarments or undergarment lines must not be visible

Any student in violation of the dress code will be removed from class until proper attire is obtained. Demerits may be given for repeated offenses.
