Welcome to a new year of Faith Formation at St. Andrew. This handbook is updated yearly in an effort to answer some of the most commonly asked questions about our program. We hope that it will serve you well. Your suggestions are always welcomed.

ADMISSIONS

We are pleased to accept your child into our Religious Education program. We require that you complete a registration form for each child entering our program. We also require a copy of their Baptismal certificate.

If you are transferring your child to us from another parish, we also require a letter of transfer from that Parish. If your child has not received any prior instruction, he/she will be evaluated and may require remedial instruction.

REGISTRATION FEES

On the registration form, fees for each grade level are listed. These fees are used for books, supplies, weekly handouts, and other needs of the program. The fees for sacramental years are higher to include additional costs for retreat days/evenings, study materials, etc. *Any family experiencing financial hardship should speak with Fr. Peter or Fr. Manuel.*

CLASS LOCATION AND PARKING

Classes are held in the former Stella Maris School building directly across from the church on Division St. Parking is limited in front of the school. However, there is a parking lot directly behind the church. Caution should be taken when crossing Division Street.

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

Children should be dropped off and picked up by a parent or legal guardian. If someone other than the parent or legal guardian is to pick up the child, we must be informed of that prior to the start of class (form is included in this handbook and also available on the church webpage).

ABSENCE/TARDINESS

In your registration packet, a calendar is included which indicates the days that classes are in session and other important dates to remember. You can also access this calendar on our webpage <u>www.standrewchurchsagharborny.org</u>. If you need a printed copy, stop by the parish office. Your child is expected to arrive on time and attend every class. If because of illness or emergency, your child is going to be absent or late, please call 725-0123 prior to 5PM on the day of class. If more than four absences or late arrivals occur, attendance at make-up classes is required. If your child falls into this category, you will be contacted by the Director.

EARLY DISMISSAL

Please advise the Director/Catechist prior to the start of class if you need to pick up your child before the end of the full session. Please enter the school building through the gym doors. The Director will assist you with the sign-out procedure and bring your child to you.

REQUIRED SUPPLIES

Your child will receive a textbook on the first day of Religious Formation sessions. (Grade 6, 7 and 8 will also receive a Bible). Please have your child bring a pen/pencil to each session. Lesson textbook pages may be sent home with your child each week so that the family activities can be completed.

HOMEWORK

Homework will be given to the 6th, 7th and 8th Grade on a regular basis and is a required part of the sacramental program. Homework must be completed and handed in to the Catechist on time in order to move forward in the Confirmation process.

CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE

We acknowledge and respect that all of us, young and old alike, are made in the Divine Image of God and should be treated as such. Disruptive behavior and/or behavior that is disrespectful to the dignity of another person will not be tolerated in our Catholic Christian setting.

6th through 8th Grade – if your child is disruptive in class, you will receive a phone call to pick your child up immediately. This type of behavior will not be tolerated. If the behavior continues in subsequent classes, we will ask that you remove your child from our program. The parent/guardian of a student identified as disruptive or disrespectful will be required to meet with the Pastor and the Director as is deemed necessary.

DRESS CODE

Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times....no bare midriffs, sagging pants, etc. For everyone's safety, appropriate shoes are required in the school building (no roller-skate heeled shoes or flip-flops). Hoods, hats and coats must be removed during class. No heavy jewelry or chains may be worn into the school building or any other attire that could be used as a weapon.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

IPODS, IPADS, MP3 players and the like should be left at home. Cell phones must be turned off during class. No texting will be permitted.

VANDALISM

Any student caught vandalizing on the parish or school property will be responsible for the repair of damages. Those damages could also result in the removal of that child from the faith formation program.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Substance abuse is defined as the possession of, use of, selling or distributing any unauthorized, illegal drug, chemical, alcohol, or tobacco-like substance which can be introduced into the body through ingestion, inhalation, or injection. Any student found in possession of an illegal or unauthorized substance on parish property or at parish-sponsored events will be immediately suspended from the program. Any student selling or distributing will be turned over to the local authorities.

<u>SAFETY</u>

The school doors are locked from the inside during sessions to provide a safe environment for our children and young people. Only the Director/office staff may admit people into the building after the doors are locked. Please come to the gym doors when attempting to enter the building. No unauthorized person will be allowed in the classroom. Authorization to enter a classroom must be obtained in advance from Fr. Manuel and/or the Staff Attendant.

The fire drill/evacuation procedure is posted in every room near the door. Please ask your child to become familiar with it.

Finally, please let the Religious Formation office know about any order of protection in effect for any child in our program or any other safety concerns.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

In the case of severe snow, ice and/or storm conditions, sessions will be cancelled. For the 6th through 8th grades please note that if the public schools have been closed, classes will be cancelled for the evening.

This year we are asking for your e-mail addresses so that items of this nature can be forwarded to you in a timely manner. If you have not provided your email address to us, please call the parish office.

COMPLAINTS:

In the event you may have a complaint regarding our faith formation program, please speak firstly to Fr. Manuel, your child's Catechist, and our Pastor, Fr. Peter. If satisfaction is not reached, contact the Diocese of Rockville Centre Office of Faith Formation at 516 678-5800 ext. 506
