John All, Ph.D. & J.D.

Dr. John All is most recently known for his rousing story of human resiliency and survival that made international headlines. All—an associate professor of geography at Western Kentucky University as well as an avid climber and environmentalist—fell down a seven-story crevasse on an expedition to Nepal's Mount Himlung (near Annapurna). After a fall that left him with eleven broken bones including a broken right arm, internal bleeding, and multiple lacerations, All was stuck on a tiny ledge in the ice

with an infinite void below and 70 daunting feet above that he would have to surmount in order to survive...

You will be given a glimpse into Dr. All's seven strategies of overcoming obstacles and reaching one's goals.
