Your donations of spectacles brought joy as people said "Now I can see" Several people were referred to the hospital and one young girl was sent to Nairobi University Hospital for treatment of serious ulceration on her eyes. We committed again to fund a cataract operation.



This November we will be holding Medical Camps in partnership with The Peoples Church and Kerugoya District Hospital.



We visited Cindi's Hope Orphanage and tested several of the children who could not read the blackboard.

For Business Start Ups we are creating a fund from which grants can be made to help the people start their own business.

Our Bradford optician donated new eye charts for use in the hospital . Further supplies of dressings etc are planned,



We brought an electric drill and mixer bit to stir soap which the blind group prepared for sale. Again a meal & food to take home will be provided. Moulds for making block soap will be taken this November.
