The *optional* three-hour **Breastfeeding Course for Doulas** offered the evening prior to the Birth Doula Workshop satisfies the breastfeeding class attendance certification requirement for those who are not lactation counselors, lactation educators, lactation consultants, breastfeeding peer counselors or La Leche League leaders. This requirement can also be met by observing a breastfeeding class or workshop that meets certain criteria or participating in the on-line course option approved by DONA International.*
