In the US, TENS units have been used for years by physical therapists in their rehabilitation of injured patients. TENS can make a woman more comfortable in labor by using electrical stimulation to increase the release of the body's natural pain-relieving substances and by blocking the nerve pathways that cause labor pain. Obstetric TENS has been found to be an effective technique for pain control in over 80 percent of births, especially for back pain in labor, and has no known harmful effects to mother or baby. Learn to use TENS with your clients, how to explain its use, how to apply it, and when it is and is not recommended. Add this new tool to your birth bag for even more options for your clients.
